In order to export dogs/cats to **China**, the following lists are required:

****1 passenger per 1 pet**

1. Passport of the exporter, *hardcopy versions*.
2. The microchip certificate, *both original and copy*.
 - Must conform to international standards ISO 11784 and 11785 (15-bit microchip code contain only numbers)
3. Your pets have to be over 16 weeks old
4. Vaccination record/booklet with details of pets, *both original and hardcopy*.
 - Each vaccination must include all of the following information: (1) date of vaccination, (2) vaccine product information, and (3). veterinarians' detail: full name, license number, and signature of a veterinarian who administered the vaccination.
 - Your pet must have been vaccinated at least TWICE in its lifetime, and be current on rabies vaccinations at the time of arrival in China.
5. The report of the serology test for rabies, *both original and copy*.
 - Blood collection date should not be earlier than second rabies vaccination (either on the same day or later) the result is **valid 1 year** after the date of sampling.

Please, bring all the required documents in both hardcopy and original versions with your pets to the Animal Quarantine Station for physical examination within 1-5 days prior to the departure date without any reservation needed. We are open Monday-Friday (except Thai public holidays) 08:30 am - 12:00 pm and 01:00 pm - 03:30 pm.

All the processes here will take about 2-3 hours; we will provide you the official health certificate and export permit. Please prepare 250 THB/pet and 10 THB/Shipment for a fee (Cash only).
