

In order to export dogs/cats to **China**, the following lists are required:

**1 passenger per 1 pet

- 1. Passport of the exporter, hardcopy versions.
- 2. The microchip certificate, both original and copy.
 - Must conform to international standards ISO 11784 and 11785 (15-bit microchip code contain only numbers)
- 3. Your pets have to be over 16 weeks old
- 4. Vaccination record/booklet with details of pets, *both original* and hardcopy.
 - Each vaccination must include all of the following information: (1) date of vaccination, (2) vaccine product information, and (3). veterinarians' detail: full name, license number, and signature of a veterinarian who administered the vaccination.
 - Your pet must have been vaccinated at least TWICE in its lifetime, and be current on rabies vaccinations at the time of arrival in China.
- 5. The report of the serology test for rabies, both original and copy.
 - Blood collection date should not be earlier than second rabies vaccination (either on the same day or later) the result is valid 1 year after the date of sampling.

Please, bring all the required documents in both hardcopy and original versions with your pets to the Animal Quarantine Station for physical examination within 1-5 days prior to the departure date without any reservation needed. We are open Monday-Friday (except Thai public holidays) 08:30 am - 12:00 pm and 01:00 pm - 03:30 pm.

All the processes here will take about 2-3 hours; we will provide you the official health certificate and export permit. Please prepare 250 THB/pet and 10 THB/Shipment for a fee (Cash only).
