

In order to export dogs/cats to **Malaysia**, the following lists are required:

- 1. Passport of the exporter, hardcopy versions.
- 2. Microchip implantation
- 3. Your pets have to be over 4 months old
- 4. **Vaccination record/booklet** with pets' details, both original and hardcopy.
 - The pets must be continuously **rabies** and **combination vaccinated** and the recent one is still valid until the departure date.
 - Each vaccination must include all of the following information: (1) date of vaccination, (2) vaccine product information, and (3). veterinarian's detail: full name, license number, and signature of a veterinarian who administered the vaccination.

In case of any correction the veterinarian's signature is required.

- 5. Import permit (contact Malaysia animal quarantine station)
- 6. Rabies free zone certificate (contact local department of livestock development)
 - Rabies has not been reported within the area where the animal has lived for the last 6 (six) months.
- 7. Other documents regarding import permit. (If any)

Please, bring all the required documents in both hardcopy and original versions with your pets to the Animal Quarantine Station for physical examination within 1-5 days prior to the departure date without any reservation needed. We are open Monday-Friday (except Thai public holidays) 08:30 am - 12:00 pm and 01:00 pm - 03:30 pm.

All the processes here will take about 2-3 hours; we will provide you the official health certificate and the export permit. Please prepare 250 THB/pet and 10 THB/Shipment for a fee (Cash only).
