



South Korea

In order to export dogs/cats to **South Korea**, the following lists are required:

The dogs and cats younger than 90 days

1. Passport of the exporter, *both original and hardcopy versions*.
2. Microchip implantation

The dogs and cats aged 90 days or older

1. Passport of the exporter, *both original and hardcopy versions*.
2. Microchip implantation
3. Vaccination record/booklet with details of pets, *both original and hardcopy*.
 - Each vaccination must include all of the following information: (1) date of vaccination, (2) vaccine product information, and (3). veterinarians' detail: full name, license number, and signature of a veterinarian who administered the vaccination.
 - The pets must be continuously rabies vaccinated and the recent one is still valid until the departure date.
4. The report of the rabies titer test, both original and copy (if any)
 - The test must be administered by an internationally approved laboratory within 24 months prior to boarding.
 - Must measure a level of neutralizing antibody to rabies virus in serum greater than 0.5 IU/ml.

In case of any correction the veterinarian's signature is required.

Please, bring all the required documents in both hardcopy and original versions with the pets to the Animal Quarantine Station for physical examination within 1-5 days prior to the departure date without any reservation needed. We are open Monday-Friday (except Thai public holidays) 08:30 am - 12:00 pm and 01:00 pm - 03:30 pm.

All the processes here will take about 2-3 hours; we will provide you the official health certificate and the export permit. Please prepare 250 THB/pet and 10 THB/Shipment for a fee (Cash only).

DISCLAIMER: An animal that has not received a rabies-neutralizing antibody test or whose rabies-neutralizing antibody titer is 0.5IU/ml or lower, shall be quarantined for an extended period of time, all at the owner's expense.
