## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF PIGEONS PARTICIPATING IN "PATTAYA INTERNATIONAL PIGEON RACE 2018" "THAILAND WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2018" AND "THAILAND GRAND PIGEON RACE 2018"

- 1) A health certificate in English signed by an authorized veterinary official of the exporting country stating:-
  - 1.1) number,
  - 1.2) identification number,
  - 1.3) names and addresses of the owner/exporter and the consignee,
  - 1.4) import permit number which was issued by DLD
  - 1.5) certification of condition items (2) to (8).
- The collect place is free from high pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) for the past thirty (30) days prior to export.
- 3) The area within 2 km radius around the collect place is free from high pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) for the past thirty (30) days prior to export.
- 4) The collect place has been free from velogenic Newcastle disease for the past six (6) months prior to export.
- 5) The birds have not been vaccinated against avian influenza disease.
- 6) The birds have been kept at the collect place and showed no clinical of infectious and contagious disease.
- 7) The birds have been examined on the day of export and found to be free from any clinical signs of infectious and contagious diseases.
- 8) The boxes or containers in which the birds are accommodated for export to Thailand should be followed the International Air Transport Association (IATA) specifications, particularly in relation to height, perch space and ventilation, and with adequate access for feeding and watering.
- 9) The birds are subject to quarantine on arrival at approved premises, for a period of at least 30 (thirty) days. Samples from each bird must be collected on day 2 and day 21 of quarantine period for avian influenza and Newcastle disease testing. The importer/owner shall be fully charged for the incurred expenses.
- 10) Failure to follow the import procedures may result in returning the birds to the country of origin or destroying without compensation.

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
